CAMP DIRECTOR/FOUNDER

OUR PROGRAM GOALS

The goals of KJK Theatre Camp include enhancing children's growth through involvement in the arts in a fun and engaging environment where they meet new friends and make lifelong memories. The campers boost their self-esteem while working as a team for a common goal. In addition, they experience the pride of knowing that their hard work has culminated in an amazing final product.

ENROLLMENT/PROCEDURE

- Fill out an application (for each child) & return with full payment, medical information and a wallet size school picture or other small snapshot.
- Orientations will be held at the Yorktown Jewish Center.

 - Junior Camps: Ages 6-9: Wednesday, June 13th 4pm-6pm
 - Junior Camps: Ages 10-12: Wednesday, June 13th 6pm-8pm
 - Teen Camps: Ages 12-13: Wednesday, June 20nd 4pm-6pm
 - Teen Camps: Ages 14-16: Wednesday, June 20rd 6pm-8pm
 - Parents: Please understand that when enrolling your camper into KJK Theatre Camp, you are enrolling them into a theatrical team "experience." Every camper and every part matters.
 - All participants are accepted to our program.
 - In each session production, most of the character roles are divided to spread the experience among our participants.
 - There is no orientation for parents.
 - All campers must attend the entire orientation period.
 - Past camp participants must attend the orientation.
 - No child will be permitted to attend the orientation unless payment is made in full.
 - Junior camp participants must prepare 16 bars (small segment) of any song from the shows we are doing, a Disney show or show music. Please no pop/radio music. Please bring own sheet music if he/she is not singing from one of the shows we are doing.
 - Teen camp participants must prepare a one-minute memorized monologue/expressive reading or improvisation and 16 bars of any song. Please no pop/radio music. Please bring own sheet music if he/she is not singing from one of the shows we are doing.
- Script/role assignment.
 - Junior sessions will receive their script and role during the first day of camp
 - Teen sessions will receive their script/role via email on/before the following dates:
 - Teen A June 25
 - Teen B July 9

- Tickets to final performance
Tickets for all performances are \$12 for front center seats, and \$10 for rear center and side seats. Ticket forms and payments will only be accepted at orientations, and Tuesday's during camp. Please have form and payment in a sealed envelope with campers name on it. Credit cards not accepted.
- In order to comply with the rules of our rental agreement at the Yorktown Jewish Center, we ask all of our participants to bring a **meatless**, healthful lunch and snack each day.

FEE COMBINATIONS

Any child who is enrolled for more than one session will save **\$30** off total summer tuition. Enroll more than one child in our camp and save **\$20** per additional child, off total summer tuition.

Our Tax ID# 13-3221709. A final "receipt of payment letter" for all 2012 child care tax purposes will be mailed out at the end of the summer. KJK will not be able to issue another receipt until January, 2013. There will be an additional charge of \$2 for a lost receipt.

REFUND POLICY:

If a person withdraws from a session prior to June 25, 2012, then the total fee (minus 25% for administrative costs) will be refunded. 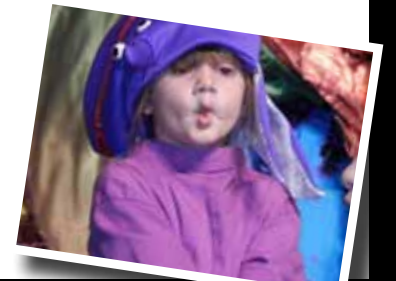
