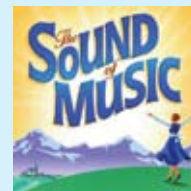

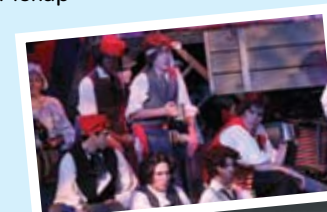

CAMP LOCATION

CAMP FOUNDER/DIRECTOR

Kevin J. Kearins, Producer and Artistic Director since 1982, will supervise the staff for the KJK Theatre Camp and direct its productions. He has produced more than 75 Mainstage and over 35 children's theatre productions in the Yorktown Theatre, Tarrytown and the Tri-state area. He has had extensive training, both nationally and in Europe, in all aspects of Voice and Theatre & Arts Administration. Mr. Kearins holds a Bachelors and Masters in Education/Theatre and is a member of SDC (the professional national union of Society of Stage Directors & Choreographers.)

OUR PROGRAM GOALS

The goals of KJK Theatre Camp include enhancing children's growth through involvement in the arts in a fun and engaging environment where they meet new friends and make lifelong memories. The campers boost their self-esteem while working as a team for a common goal. In addition, they experience the pride of knowing that their hard work has culminated into an amazing final product.

ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE

1. Fill out an application (for each child) & return with full payment, medical information and a wallet-size school picture or other small snapshot.

2. Orientations will be held at the Yorktown Jewish Center.

- All Participants are accepted to our program.
- Camper Orientation is scheduled for both staff and participants.
- There is no orientation for parents.
- All campers must attend the entire orientation period for each camp session.
- Past camp participants must attend the orientation.
- No child will be permitted to attend the orientation unless payment is made in full.
- Junior Camp & Camp D participants must prepare 16 bars (small segment) of any song from the shows we are doing, Disney, or show music. They can also bring sheet music for their own song selection. Please no pop/radio music.
- Teen Workshop participants must prepare a one-minute memorized monologue/expressive reading or improvisation and 16 bars of any song. Please bring sheet music if not singing from shows we are doing. Please no pop/radio music or Disney for teen camps.

3. Informational sheet on camper requirements (costume, lunch, etc.) will be mailed to each parent and will posted on our website by June 21, 2010.

4. Script/Role Assignment

- Junior sessions will receive their scripts and roles during the first day of camp.
- Teen sessions will receive their script/role via email on/before the following dates:
Teen A June 28
Teen B July 19

*****Please make sure that we have an email address for all teen campers and all parents!

• In each session production, most of the character roles are divided to spread the experience among our participants.

5. Camp sessions begin

Junior camps	9am-3pm
Teen camps	9:30am-4pm

6. Drop Off/Pickup

(We ask you to please cooperate to reduce congestion and prevent traffic problems)

Junior Camps drop off at 8:45-9am, pickup 2:45-3pm

Teen Camps drop off 9:15-9:30am, pickup at 3:45-4pm.

*Early drop off or late pickup can be arranged for an extra fee.

7. *New Early Drop Off / Late Pick Up

Early drop-off: Junior Camp: 7:30am-8:45am, Teen Camp 7:30am-9:15am

Late pick-up: 3pm-6pm Junior Camp, 4pm-6pm Teen Camp (5:30pm on Friday's for both camps)

For Junior Camp:

- If dropped off between 7:30 and 8:30am, the charge is \$10. If dropped off between 8:30 and 9:00am, the charge is \$5.
- If picked up between 3 and 4pm, the charge is \$5. If picked up between 4 and 5pm, the charge is \$10. If picked up between 5 and 6pm, the charge is \$15.

For Teen Camp:

- If dropped off between 7:30 and 8:30am, the charge is \$10. If dropped off between 8:30 and 9:30am, the charge is \$5.
- If picked up between 3 and 4pm, the charge is \$5. If picked up between 4 and 5pm, the charge is \$10. If picked up between 5 and 6pm, the charge is \$15.

This may be paid for in advance or per day the service is needed. When dropping off or picking up, please sign-in your camper(s).

8. Tickets to final performance

We are hoping to have a new online ticketing program for all camp performances. After a completed registration you will receive an e-mail with directions on how to reserve your tickets.

9. In order to comply with the rules of our rental agreement at the Yorktown Jewish Center, we ask all of our participants to bring a meatless, healthy lunch and snack each day.

FEE COMBINATIONS

Any family who refers a new camper(s) who registers for a KJK camp session will save \$20. Any child who is enrolled for two or more sessions will save \$30 off a second and/or third session. Enroll more than one child in our camp and deduct \$20 off tuition of second and third child for one camp session.


Our Tax ID# 13-3221709, please save our final "receipt of payment letter" for all 2010 child care tax purposes, KJK will not be able to issue another receipt until January, 2011. There will be an additional charge of \$2 for a lost receipt.

REFUND POLICY

If a camper withdraws from a session prior to June 21, 2010, then the total fee (minus 25% for administrative costs) will be refunded. There will be no refunds for any person for any reason after June 21, 2010. KJK Theatre Camp has the right to dismiss any child for behavioral problems. Money will not be refunded for days missed due to dismissal or illness.
